Squadding

The Ball Trap has been presquadded. On Sunday 8th March you will need to go to the squadding room and you will be allocated a squad number for the next seven NZ Championship Matches.

Squadding for the Double Rise & Minis will start on the 7th March at 10am.

Squads will be rotated from Triples Day on the 10th March so please ensure you check the squad rotation board in the clubrooms before leaving each day.

Trophy Matches

If shooting a trophy/cash divide match either

- go to the squadding room **after** you have shot the NZ Championship match, especially if you are in the first waves.

OR

- if you are not shooting a Championship match you can squad at anytime. The earlier you squad the better to ensure we get through our full programme.

For the Grouse Trophy match the club may restrict entries.

Dogs

No dogs are allowed on the premises for the duration of the NZ DTL National Championships and the 16th ICTSF World DTL Championships.

Campers

Reminder – you can only come into the grounds from the 5th March and out by the 19th March.

Practice Tokens

Are available from the bar. Cost is \$15 for 25 targets (5 tokens)

Unlicenced Shooters

Must be supervised by a Firearms Licenced person when competing plus when walking to and from the trap. Supervisors are to be on lanes 2 & 4.

Firearms Storage

Is by the bar area. When presenting your firearms for storage they must be locked. Cost is \$50 for both tournaments or \$30 for World Champs only.

Sighter Targets

Before the beginning of a round and after each subsequent setting of the traps, the referee shall show the squad one regulation target, or pair of targets in Double Rise. A shooter may also ask to have one regular target, or pair of targets in Double Rise, thrown after each irregular target

Dress Code
